Denmark, Euro-super 95: Denmark's Bulletin figure is not a pump-price survey: the Danish Competition and Consumer Authority reports current consumer prices minus the previous quarter's average discounts (Commission country notes). Our figure is the pump price the brands publish through their legally mandated price APIs. Over the 10 bulletins from 20 July to 21 September 2026, the Bulletin's Danish Euro-super 95 was 8.8–12.1% above our weekly average pump price and 0.9–4.6% above Drivkraft Danmark's daily recommended retail price; for diesel the two stayed within 5%.

! = more than 5% apart. The two measures differ: live is the current price in the market's official feed when collected (station average where the feed lists every station); the bulletin is the national average each government reports for the bulletin date.
