Real high = the highest price in today's money (Aug 2026 euros, Eurostat HICP). Dates in the image are months (Sep '26 = September 2026); the CSV and JSON have the exact bulletin week of every record.

Record = the highest or lowest weekly national average price, taxes included, in the EU Weekly Oil Bulletin since 3 Jan 2005, the start of our archive (Bulgaria and Romania from 2008, Croatia from 2013). If a value was reached more than once, the first week counts.

Data checks: values of zero and isolated jumps of more than 25% against both neighbouring weeks are left out (1); our archive is re-aligned every week with the Commission's history file, so weeks the Commission revised after publication carry the revised figure; 10 country-weeks are missing in the bulletin history and are not filled in.

In today's money = price × HICP of Aug 2026 ÷ HICP of the month of the price. HICP = the EU's harmonised index of consumer prices, all items (Eurostat, dataset prc_hicp_minr, which replaced prc_hicp_midx in 2026; index 2015 = 100). Aug 2026 is the latest month Eurostat has published; weeks after it are not adjusted. The EU average uses the EU-27 index, each country its own.

Countries that do not use the euro (Czechia, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Sweden): the bulletin reports their prices in € converted at each week's exchange rate, so adjusting them with national inflation would mix inflation with exchange-rate moves — shown as n/a. Croatia is adjusted from July 2020 and Slovakia from January 2009, when their currencies became fixed to the euro; Denmark and Bulgaria are included because their currencies are fixed to the euro.

Denmark (petrol): Denmark's Bulletin figure is current consumer prices minus the previous quarter's average discounts, not a survey of pump prices.
