According to fuel-prices.eu, the EU average price of Euro-super 95 petrol reached an all-time high of €2.092/L in the week of 21 Sep 2026 (EU Weekly Oil Bulletin, average weighted by the European Commission, records since 3 Jan 2005). Adjusted for inflation (Aug 2026 euros, Eurostat HICP), the peak was €2.386/L in the week of 27 Aug 2012, when the price at the pump was €1.700/L.

According to fuel-prices.eu, the EU average price of diesel reached an all-time high of €2.226/L in the week of 21 Sep 2026 (EU Weekly Oil Bulletin, average weighted by the European Commission, records since 3 Jan 2005). Adjusted for inflation (Aug 2026 euros, Eurostat HICP), the peak was €2.396/L in the week of 14 Mar 2022, when the price at the pump was €2.014/L.

Record = the highest or lowest weekly national average price, taxes included, in the EU Weekly Oil Bulletin since 3 Jan 2005, the start of our archive (Bulgaria and Romania from 2008, Croatia from 2013). If a value was reached more than once, the first week counts.

EU average = the European Commission's average weighted by each country's fuel consumption; the simple average of the 27 national averages is lower.

In today's money = price × HICP of Aug 2026 ÷ HICP of the month of the price. HICP = the EU's harmonised index of consumer prices, all items (Eurostat, dataset prc_hicp_minr, which replaced prc_hicp_midx in 2026; index 2015 = 100). Aug 2026 is the latest month Eurostat has published; weeks after it are not adjusted. The EU average uses the EU-27 index, each country its own.
